

In his letter, addressed to first open letter signatories, Tom Mount, Chairman of the IANTD Board:

- is surprised by the fact that the signatories do not comply to the IANTD QA findings
- mentions, that Roman Nowak had threatened the members of QA Board, which is why it was dissolved and replaced by the three members convened, two from Europe and one from USA, all three of them highly competent specialists
- evokes five of the previous QA Board conclusions, supposedly to prove the Board's effectiveness and honesty
- points the unreliability of Roman Nowak's report towards the exact number of the stage bottles carried by the deceased Krzysztof Betiuk
- confirms his full support on QA Board's decision towards Andrzej Kruczkowski's eligibility restitution
- undermines the validity of any statements or reports, posted on social media eg Facebook, pointing to the long term IANTD policy towards the abuses which have occurred among the platform users, and passes the precipitate judgement and public slander towards an individual who happened to be a member of both IANTD and ICURR, as an example of such abuse
- stresses the fact that he respects all the open letter signatories, however it stands in contrary to the conclusions of QA Board
- points out the IANTD HQ high range and respect.
